



Introducing: New Literacy Profile Reports

Curriculum Associates Brief | May 2026

Available with the **17.1/July 18 Release**, Literacy Profile Reports will now be expanded to include a class level report as well as school and district level reports. Teachers will be able to view *i-Ready Inform* placements, Benchmark Literacy Tasks results, and Early Literacy/Dyslexia Screening in a single table for a unified view of **whole class literacy performance**. Administrators will have access to this data for their **entire school or district**.

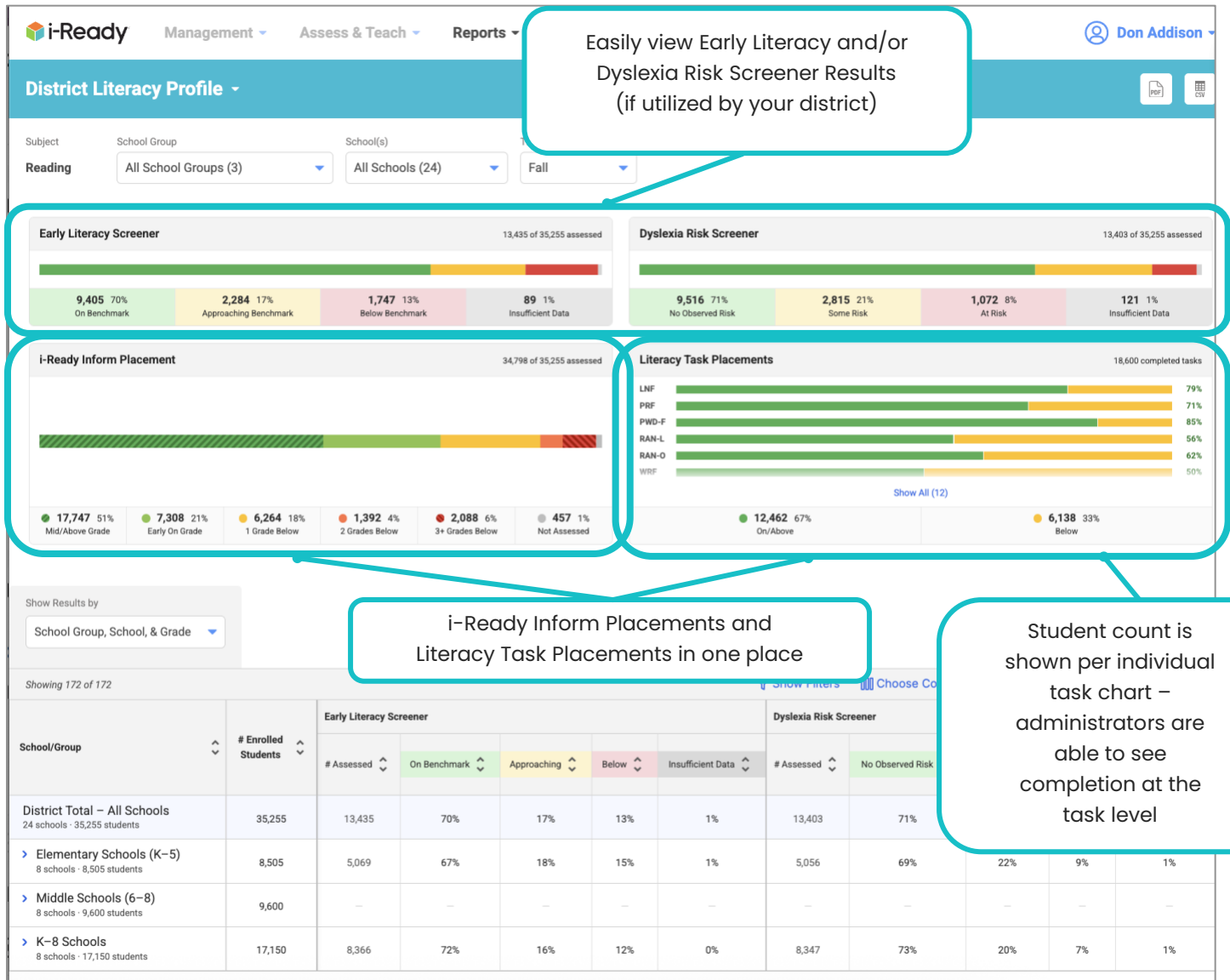

Callouts:

- Filter by assessment type and sort results:** Points to the filter and sort options at the top of the table.
- Easily access i-Ready Inform and Literacy Tasks results:** Points to the links for the detailed reports.
- Easily view and sort by Early Literacy and/or Dyslexia Screener results if utilized by your district:** Points to the Early Literacy and Dyslexia Risk Screener columns.
- Student results are shown by Fall, Winter, and Spring, so growth patterns are visible at a glance:** Points to the Time of Year column.
- Spot students who may be at risk and drill into their individual profile in one click:** Points to the student names (Simpson, Roma, Melton, Anita, Vargas, Diego).

Other Enhancements Coming to Literacy Profile Reports for the 2026–2027 School Year

- We are adding the **Accuracy** metric for Passage Reading Fluency to the Student Literacy Profile Report
- **Setting that allows display of Early Literacy Screener Results only and/or Dyslexia Screener Results** across all Literacy Screener Reports (Student, Class, District/School).
- **Save Table Views:** Allow users to save named table configurations (column selection, sort, filters)
- **Show Results By Demographics or by Class:** Additional demographic breakdowns within the report.
