The following list of words from the decodable text may be unfamiliar to students. Provide word meanings as needed when students read the relevant text part.

### ***From Trading To Paying***

#### **Part 1**

**case** – all of the facts and conditions of a certain place and time

**bartering** – trading something you have for something someone else has without using money

**invented** – made something new that nobody has done before

**soybeans** – seeds from a plant that is part of the pea family used to make many foods

#### **Part 2**

**cash** – money in the form of coins and bills

**spoil** – go bad and can't be used

**valuable** – worth more money than other things are

**transport** – carry

#### **Part 3**

**credit card** – a plastic card used to buy things that you will pay for later

**debit card** – a plastic card used to buy things by having the money taken from your bank account

**electronic money** – money that is managed and exchanged by computer systems using the Internet
