How Do Birds Communicate?

Part 1

- chirp** – a short, sharp sound a bird makes
- tweet** – a short, high sound a bird makes
- communicate** – share information
- pattern** – the regular, repeated way something is done
- claim** – say something belongs to you
- attract** – make others like you and want to come to you

Part 2

- predators** – animals that hunt other animals for food
- risks** – chances that something bad will happen
- track down** – find
- flock members** – birds in a certain group

Part 3

- fake** – (v) trick others into thinking something is real or true
