A. Spelling

Table with 6 columns for words (hurt, skirt, Thursday, birthday, thirteen) and rows for Student's Misspelling and Points. Total points for Activity A is 8.

B. Word Reading

Table with 6 columns for words and rows for New Words, Multisyllabic Challenge Words, High-Frequency Words, and Words with Endings. Total points for Activity B is 25.

C. Passage Reading Fluency

Then Lev said they should go on and eat the birthday cake. They could turn today into another thirteenth birthday for Amber. So the pals ate the cake and had a fun time.
