<b>Type Descriptions</b> Words or phrases that explain each type	<i>Teacher: Read each description.</i> <b>Students:</b> Repeat each description. <b>Students:</b> Circle the description to be remembered.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• sailboat – a boat moved by wind filling sails, which are large pieces of cloth that catch the wind</li><li>• motorboat – a boat moved by a motor</li><li>• rowboat – a small boat that people can move by putting two oars in the water and pushing against the water</li></ul>
<b>Type Details</b>	<i>Teacher: Read each type and details.</i> <b>Students:</b> Echo read each type and details.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• sailboat – has sails, a mast, maybe a small propeller</li><li>• motorboat – has a motor that runs on gas, a propeller; able to reach high speeds</li><li>• rowboat – oars are attached to the side of the boat; rowers can face the front or back of the boat</li></ul>
<b>Examples</b>	<i>Teacher: Read each example.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Without wind, Ken’s sailboat was stuck in the lake.</li><li>• After Jordan fills the gas tank on her motorboat, she will go down the coast.</li><li>• Crystal grabbed each oar and began to row the rowboat away from the dock.</li></ul>
