Overview & Timeline

Neighborhood Programs

- All students have the option to attend a program at their Neighborhood school:
 - Based on Chicago street addresses
 - Guaranteed seat
- No application required

High School Neighborhood Program

General Education Program



Next Steps for Families & Schools:

- Go directly to the school
- Provide proof of residency
- Schools can enroll families

To find your neighborhood school, visit the GoCPS website and click School Search.

When families want to attend a school outside their assigned neighborhood school, they must go through...

GoCPS

If a student wants to attend **ANY** school outside of their Neighborhood school,

GoCPS

is the **PRIMARY** way!



- Students are not restricted to the assigned neighborhood schools or schools near their home.
- For grades K-9, students **must** go through the application process before attending any non-neighborhood school or program. **Note:** Schools manage transfer process outside of GoCPS for grades 10-12.
- Applications are submitted the year before a child will enroll.
- If a child will enroll in fall 2026, the application will be submitted in fall of 2025.

Exceptions include: OSD placement for ES, STLS placement, etc...

Application Cycle Timeline (FALL)

September 23, 2025

Application Opens

Students can begin to create GoCPS accounts and select programs to include on their application. There is no benefit to applying early.

October 8-9 & 15-16, 2025 (CPS)

HSAT Testing for Students applying to High School

Current CPS and Charter students will take the CPS High School Admissions Test (HSAT) in their current 8th grade classes. No registration is necessary.

October 18-19 & 25-26, 2025
(Non-CPS)

All non-CPS students will take the CPS High School Admissions exam at designated CPS locations. Registration for the exam is conducted through the GoCPS application.

November 14, 2025

Application Closes

All applications must be submitted by this date. Programs can not be added, removed or re-ranked after this date.

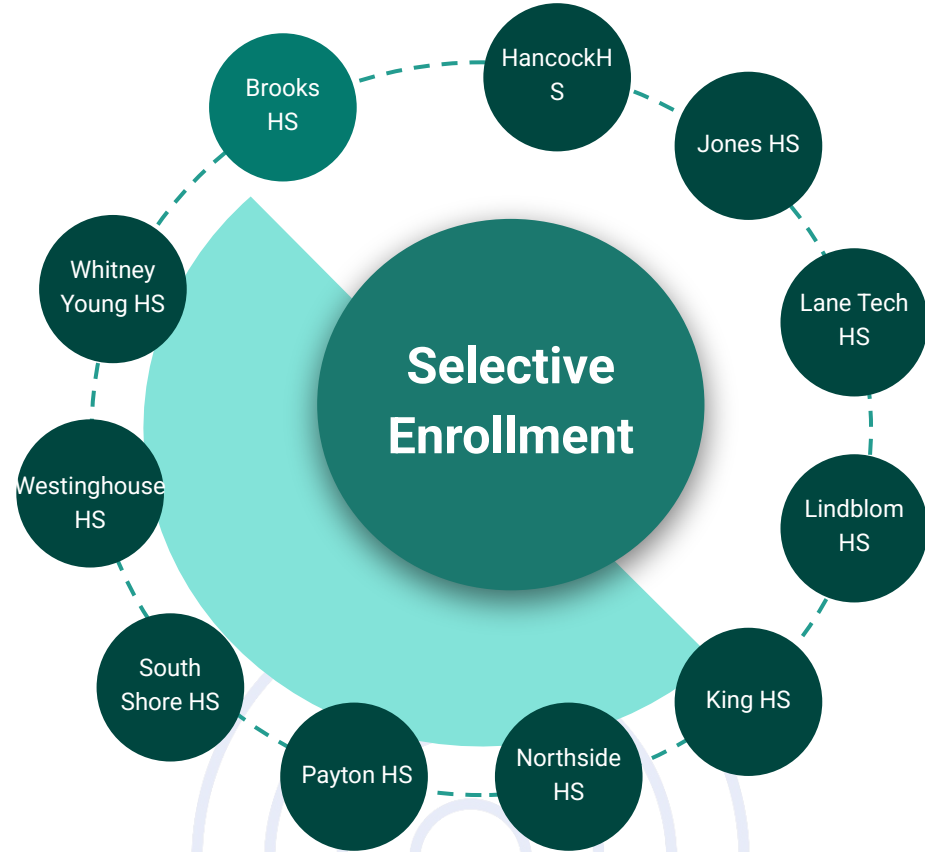
Students applying to PreK will be able to apply to all CPS and non-CPS pre K programs in the city. OECE will oversee the comms and marketing around this application.



High School Process



The high school programs listed on the GoCPS application are divided into two general categories.

Points-Based Programs Scoring Scale (with Academic Criteria)

Points based programs that use academic criteria will now be based on the same 900 point scale.

IB programs & Hubbard-Scholars will continue to give the 50 pt. Bonus for living in the geographic area making the program totals 950.

Points-Based Programs (Screening Scoring)

Any program which scores applicants through an audition, portfolio review, etc... will no longer have a additional academic criteria.

How Selections Run and Offers are Issued

- Students are placed in line for each program based on the rules outlined in each program's admissions process & priority preferences.
- The system will then try to place each student in their highest ranked program.
- All programs are considered simultaneously.

Example: The blue student is placed in line for each program that they applied to. Program A has 6 seats available. Because the student is placed in the ninth position, they will be placed on the waitlist in the #3 position. The system will then try to match the blue student with their next ranked program. If there are 7 or more seats available at Program B, the student will get an offer. If the blue student gets an offer to Program B, the system will not try to match them for any lower-ranked programs.



HOW IT WORKS- CHOICE HIGH SCHOOL PROCESS

When are applicants waitlisted?

Students are placed on the waitlist for any Choice High School that they rank higher than the offer they receive. Students are not waitlisted for programs ranked lower than the offer they receive.

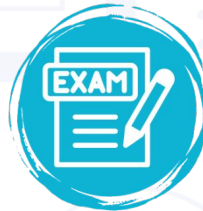

CPS Tiers - What to Know

What Are Tiers?

- Tiers are based on an applicant's home address.
- Every Census tract is assigned a Tier (1-4) based on the latest available Census data (income, education, etc.).

How to Find Your Tier:

Use the [School Search tool](#) on the GoCPS website or view on the student dashboard in the [EnrollWise](#) application platform.

When Tiers Matter:

- **Magnet** admissions (entry grade): After sibling/staff & (if applicable) pre-k & proximity preference seats, remaining seats are split evenly across the 4 Tiers.
- **Selective Enrollment** (entry grade): 30% of seats go to top scorers ("Rank"); remaining seats are evenly distributed across the 4 Tiers.

Tier is **NOT** considered for non-entry grade admissions or for any non-magnet Choice programs.

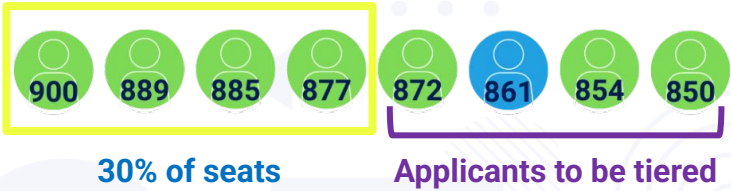
Points & Tier System Working Together

1. The system will try to match each student with their highest ranked program. Students are placed in line according to their total points. All programs are considered simultaneously.

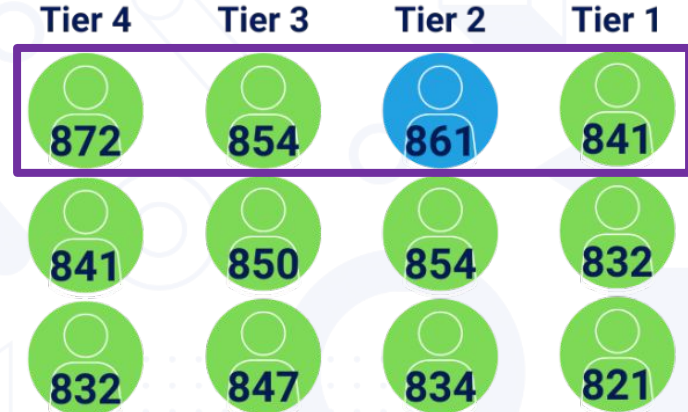
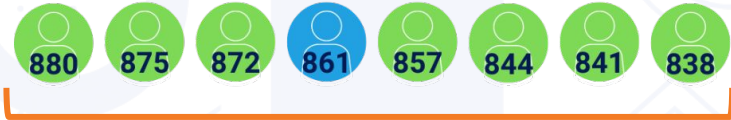
2. 30% of available seats are filled by students with the highest scores regardless of tier.

3. The remaining seats are distributed equally between the four tiers.

4. If an applicant does not receive a seat through either the top 30% or the tiers, the system will then try to match them with the program ranked #2. Once an offer is received, the system will stop trying to match a student with a program.

HOW IT WORKS- SELECTIVE ENROLLMENT HIGH SCHOOL

When are you waitlisted?

If an offer to a selective enrollment program is received, the applicant **WILL NOT** automatically be placed on any waitlists

If **NO** offer is received, the applicant will be placed on all waitlists



If an offer is received, an applicant can decline the offer and join the rolling waitlist.



CPS High School Admissions Test (HSAT)

CPS High School Admissions Test (HSAT)

What is it? One entrance exam that streamlines the GoCPS application process by allowing the same exam scores to be applied to the selections processes for all high school programs, where applicable.

Who should take this exam?

All students in 8th grade who would like to apply for admission to CPS high school choice programs or selective enrollment high schools for the 2025-2026 school year.

What do I need to know?

- Computer- Based Test
- No Calculators Allowed
- There are No Retakes
- The test will be available in 5 additional languages:
 - **Spanish**
 - **Polish**
 - **Arabic**
 - **Simplified Chinese**
 - **Urdu**

Is there a tutorial?

A tutorial session will be available for students to become familiar with the format of the exam. This session will be included at the beginning of the test and will not need to be scheduled separately.

How do Applicants Schedule & Take the Exam?

Current CPS/Charter Students

- Do NOT need to register for or schedule the exam.
- Students will test during the school day at their current 8th grade school.
- Students will select the test language at their current school.

Department of Assessment will reach out with more information and should be your point of contact for all questions regarding testing.

- The test is approximately 1 hour in length
 - 30 minutes per section
- All points-based programs- HSAT will make up 50% of the total points or 450 pts.

How do Applicants Schedule & Take the Exam?

Non-CPS Students

- Students will schedule to test when they submit their GoCPS application.
- Students will test at a designated CPS location.
- Students who need to test in a language other than English should contact our office to get scheduled.
- The test is approximately 1 hour in length
 - 30 minutes per section
- All points-based programs- HSAT will make up 50% of the total points or 450 pts.

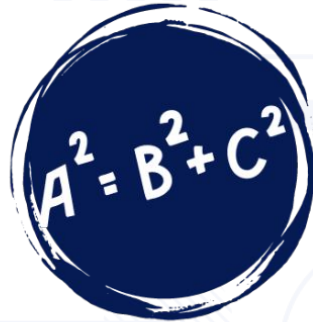

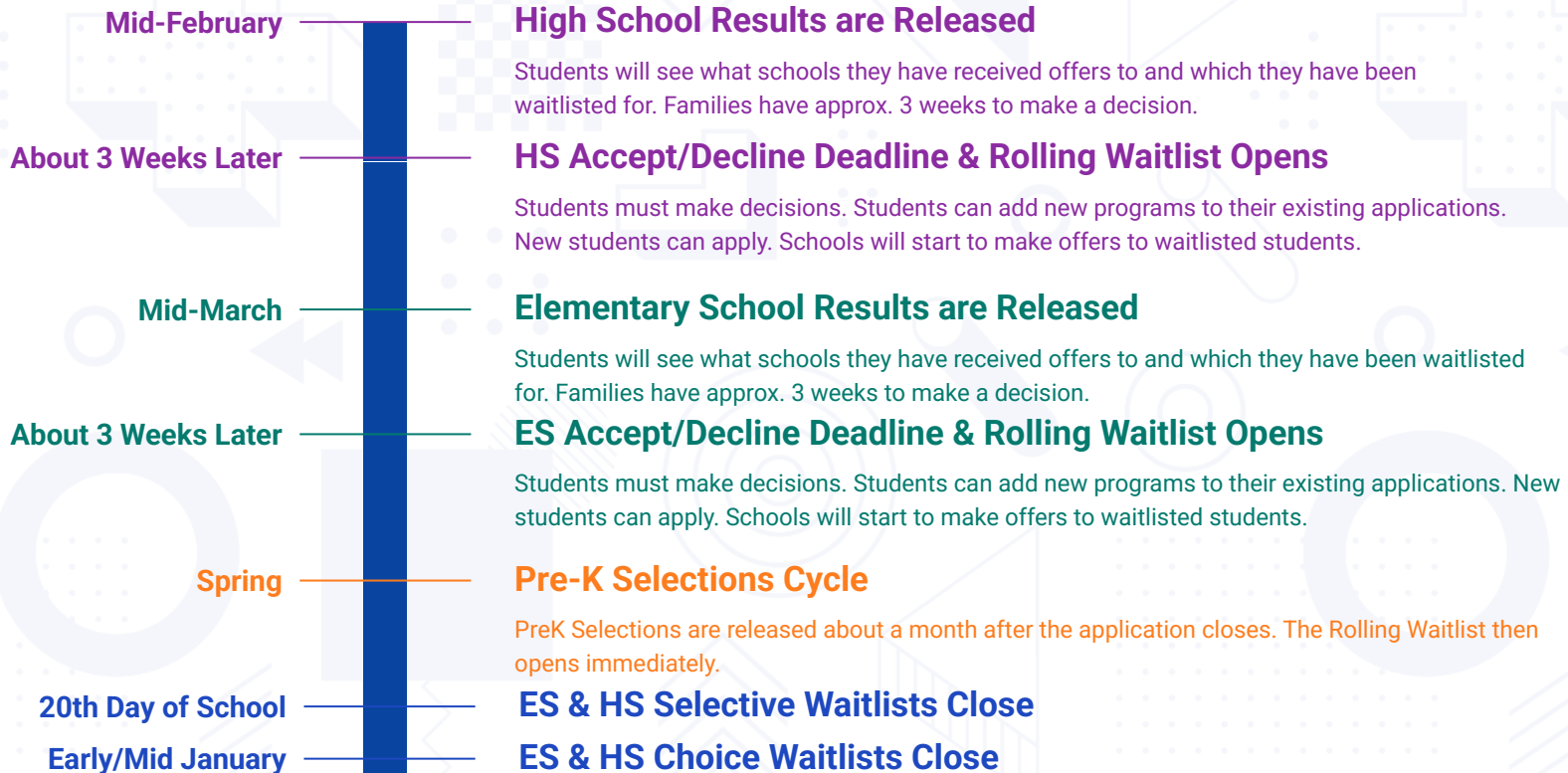

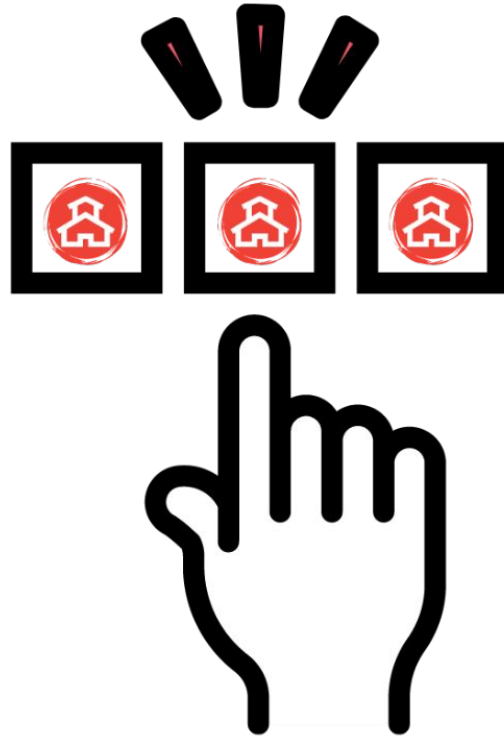
Selection Cycle Timeline (SPRING)

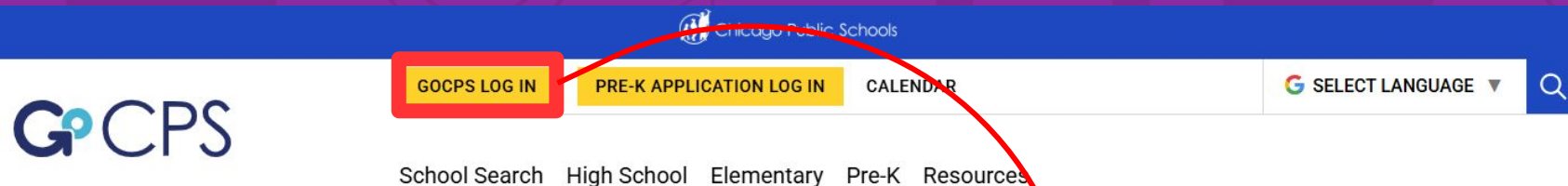

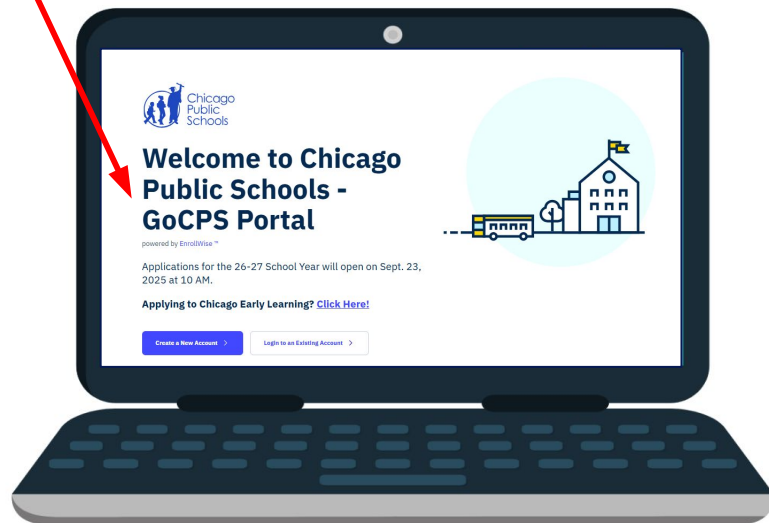

- The applicant must have a sibling who is currently enrolled and will remain enrolled for the school year, in the school to which the applicant is applying. (PreK students do not qualify unless at one of the following schools: Drummond, Suder, Inter-American)
- The currently enrolled sibling and the sibling applicant must live in the same household and have the same primary guardian.
- The term "sibling" applies only to natural siblings, step-siblings, foster siblings, and adopted siblings.

Make sure that all the information is correct with your child's current CPS or Charter school to be considered for sibling preference. Not all programs will offer sibling preference.

Staff Priority

Children of CPS staff may receive an enrollment priority to the school where the guardian works. To qualify for the staff priority, the applicant must be applying for the entry-level of that school. The guardian must be a full-time employee of that school. Only 2 seats will be offered to staff children and only if there is capacity. Add staff priority information below if you or a secondary guardian is a CPS staff member at a school where your child is applying.

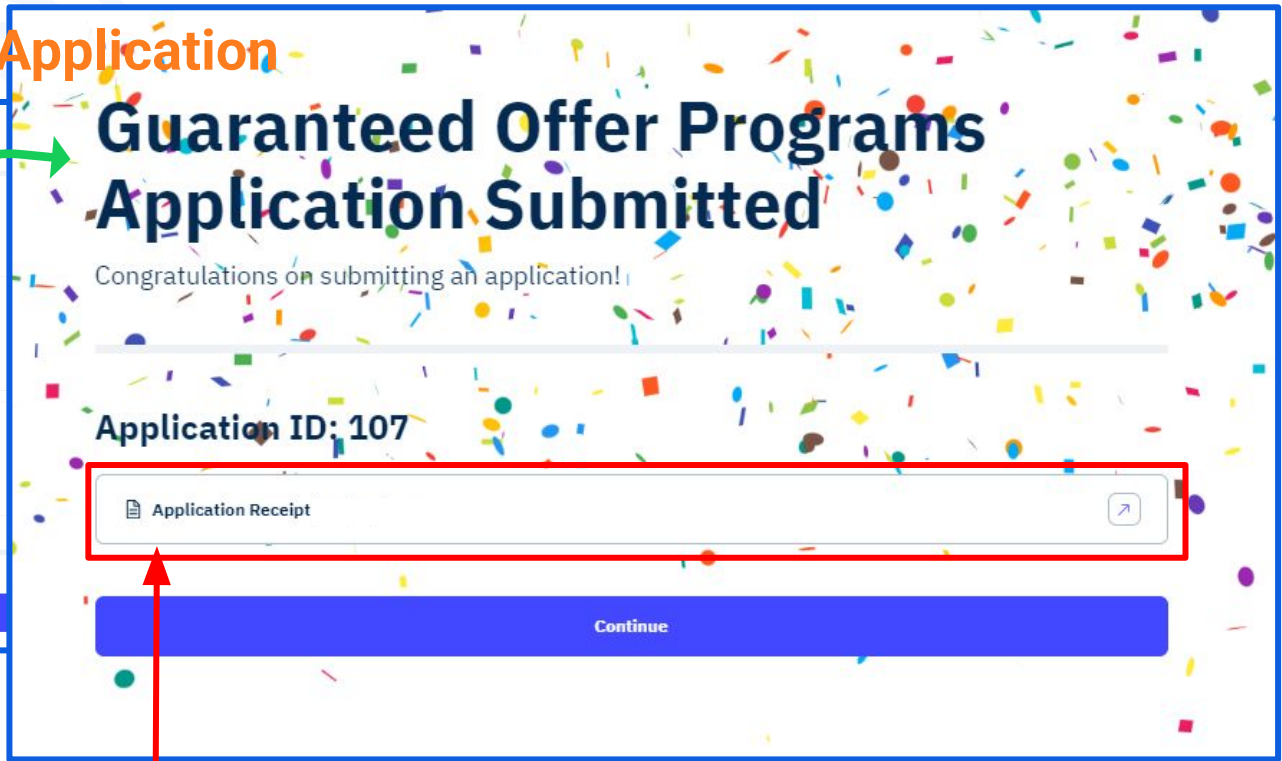

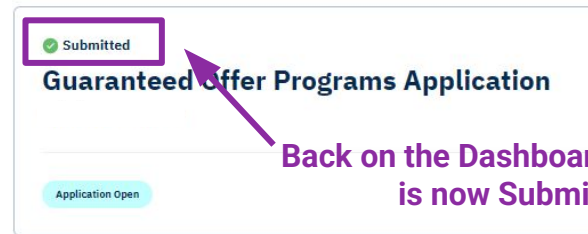

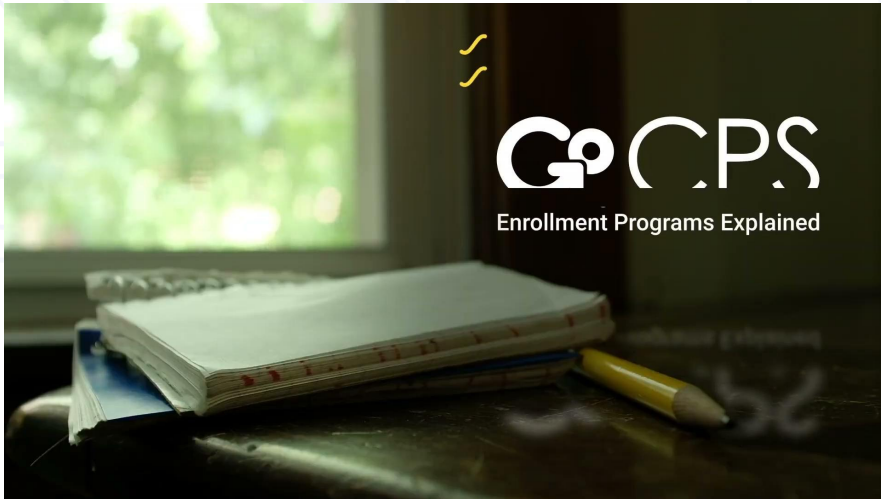
