

Metric Overview

Metric Definitions:

The Stabilization Rate is the percentage of students who enroll in an Options school that remain enrolled in any CPS school at the close of the school year or who graduate.

Metric Calculation:

Numerator:

The number of students who are enrolled at any CPS school on the last day of school or graduate by the end of the school year.

Denominator:

The number of students enrolled at an Options school with at least 45 membership days.

Key Business Rules and Exclusions:

- This metric only applies to Options schools and the students enrolled at Options schools.
- Students who have a verified transfer to another district are excluded from the denominator.
- Students who age out of CPS are included in the denominator and excluded from the numerator.

5 Students graduated + 10 Students remained enrolled at Option School A
+ 3 Students had a verified transfer to a different CPS school

Students Who Were Not Stabilized: 2 Students were not enrolled at a CPS school at the end of the year, did not graduate, and did not have a verified transfer to another school district. They are not included in the numerator.

Stabilization Use Case and Reports

Stabilization is an indicator that, when combined with other metrics, provides insight into students' sense of Connectedness and Wellbeing. Schools experiencing low Stabilization rates or showing downward-trending data can review complementary data to conduct in-depth root cause analysis. The District will support schools by prioritizing corresponding supports through their strategic plans and by providing targeted resources and support relative to the root cause.
