



- Identify the 2 parts of the Cable Lock Anchor
 - The side with the shorter tether will attach to a fixture
 - The longer tether will attach to the merchandise. The Merchandise side will also have a gray dot on the housing near the tether connection (shown in the inset above).
- Use a TT20 bit to loosen (do NOT remove) the screws in the cable clamps on each side of the Cable Anchor Lock.










- Place a charged and coded
 OneKEY into the IR Port on the
 MERCHADISE side and press the
 button.
 - **IMPORTANT:** Always release the MERCHANDISE side first. Releasing the FIXTURE side will result in an alarm event.



- Place a charged and coded
 OneKEY into the IR Port on the
 FIXTURE side and press the
 button.
- Pull the end of the tether free from the housing.











Remove the loose end of the FIXTURE tether from the cable clamp.

Route the tether around a permanent feature in the fixture.

Insert the tether into the cable clamp.









Plug the tether back into the housing.

9 Slide the cable clamp against the fixture.

Tighten the screw using a TT20 hit

Slide the cable clamp on the MERCHANDISE down to allow it to fit around the intended merchandise.

Note: The tether can be removed from the housing if this is easier for install.

Optional: The tether can be wrapped around the merchandise if desired.



If the tether was removed, insert it back into the cable clamp. Slide the cable clamp up the tether so that it is tight against the merchandise.



Plug the tether back into the housing.



Tighten the screw using a TT20 bit.



Final assembly should resemble the above image.



Remerchandising/Removal











To remerchandise or remove, place a charged and coded OneKEY into the IR Port on the MERCHADISE side and press the button.




IMPORTANT: Always release the MERCHANDISE side first. Releasing the FIXTURE side side will result in an alarm event. Remove the tether from the housing and loosen the screw in the cable clamp to access the merchandise.











Remove the tether from the cable clamp and fixture. The Cable Lock Anchor is now ready to be reinstalled.
