The Concept Feel the South

A good compromise between a guesthouse and a boutique-hotel, Kaz'alala is a tourist accommodation offering, composed of four fully renovated and lovely furnished old houses of the Bel Ombre Sugar Estate. Tucked away between the blue lagoon and the primary forest, they open out onto the pristine South, inviting overnight guests to discover the best aspects of the island's historical heritage. The public beach is a fiveminute walk away. Guests can also get to the little shops in the village by electro bike, listen to folks of the region between La Prairie and Le Morne telling stories of pirates and legends of Mauritius, wonder at the vagaries of the landscape between Chamarel and Bel Ombre or wander around rare endemic species.

Live like a local

Kaz'alala promises a hearty welcome in the finest tradition of Mauritian hospitality, embodied in the residents' host radiant smile. The host will help create unique and unforgettable memories for guests on a daily basis : a day at sea with a fisherman hiking in the region, a visit to the village to sample some delicious "dal pouris", tips to try your hand at some local cooking or to win at "carrom".





The accommodation

The houses were conceived in a way to facilitate interaction. They each consist of four or five rooms all connected internally to a common area : the emblematic creole varangue, a cosy sitting room and a fully equipped kitchen. The resident enjoys full independence: each room has an outside access to a private corner in the garden. These rooms are not wholly standardized, allowing the host to offer each guest the space that best suits their needs. It is also possible to privatise an entire house to spend time with your family, friends or during a teambuilding.

The theme for the red house, **"La Cabane du Cardinal"** (The House of the Red Fody), is inspired by the iconic Mauritius fody.

"LaKaz La Mer" (The House of the Sea) pays tribute to the marine heritage of Bel Ombre.

"La Cabane du Soleil" (The Sun Shack) reflects the country's sun-kissed climate.

"LaKaz La Vie" (The House of Life) celebrates our forests and mountains.

The facades of each of these houses feature the colours of the national flag. They are spread out in a dense garden of various typical plant trees like lychee, starfruit, Java apple, bilimbi, bread-fruit, avocado, golden apple, badamier, allspice and bambarra groundnut trees, which provide shade for sharing stories of days gone by.

The culinary settings

A restaurant with a rustic red-waxed floor, a fireplace and an aged wood dining table, Lakaz Mama has the ambiance of a hunting lodge. The courtyard's arbour covered with the herbs burgeoning in the garden contribute to creating the unique Mauritian family meetings atmosphere.

The cuisine is a typical family cooking with fresh products from the terroir and the sea. Here and there, vintage accessories set the tone: including enamelware with a blue rim in typical British colonial style, raffia table mats and tin can mugs.

For breakfast, a creole buffet mixes up with a few local delicacies : the dipin mezon (traditional Mauritian bread roll), diber pistas (peanut butter), also available eggs, crepes, jam, cereal, yogurt, gato pima (chilli bites), pomdeter karipoule (potatoes sautéed with curry leaves). A single menu is served every evening with a selection of dishes that truly reflect traditional Mauritian home cooking. According to the number of guests and their preferences, the chef will choose a suitable Themed Evening from our selection
