

Cleaning Instructions for Leather

General Maintenance

Regularly clean furniture with a 100% white cotton cloth. Dampen cloth with water only. Wipe surface. Allow furniture to air-dry. Conditioning the leather once or twice a year will restore the leather's natural moisture, preserving its softness and providing protection from dust and liquids.

If you should get a stain that cannot be removed, never experiment with strong solvents or chemicals. The problem could get worse, needing to be repaired. We recommend that you contact a professional leather cleaning service.

Antibacterial Disinfectant Maintenance

Since leather is a natural product, it is recommended that cleaning with warm water and a mild soap like Dawn will remove everything from the surface of the material. The individual cleaning will need to wash their hands and the cloth used to clean afterwards to prevent any spread of a virus to other pieces of the furniture, similar to washing your hands to remove any dirt or virus that may potentially come into contact with the surface. **Bernhardt Textiles highly does not recommend alcohol wipes because they are often too harsh on materials and, over time, will potentially remove the tannings and alter the color of the leather.**
