CARE AND CLEANING

FABRIC

"S"

Spot clean only with a water-free dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. DO NOT USE WATER. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Cushion covers should not be removed and dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling. Overall cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended.

"SW"

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion casings should not be removed and laundered or dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of affected area to prevent circling. Use a professional overall soiled condition has been reached.

"W"

Spot clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Pretest for color loss and fabric compatibility. Do not over wet. Use professional upholstery cleaning service for overall soiling.

"WS"

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushions casings should not be removed and laundered or dry cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of affected area to prevent circling.

Use a professional furniture cleaning service when an overall soiled condition has been reached.

CARE AND CLEANING

LEATHER

Under normal usage conditions, regular dusting and vacuum cleaning in crevices or under cushions is all that is necessary to clean your furniture.

For minor spots and spills:

Wipe any excess liquid up immediately with a clean absorbent cloth or sponge. If necessary, use a lightly moistened soft cloth with distilled water and let air dry naturally. Do not dry with hair dryers.

For stubborn stains:

Moisten a soft cloth or sponge with distilled water. Apply gently to all soiled portions of the leather surface. Remove water by wiping with a clean damp cloth. Blot dry with another clean soft cloth, then let air dry naturally. If the stain persists, it is recommended that the leather be cleaned by a professional leather specialist to avoid any potential damage.

For butter, oil or grease:

Blot excess butter, oil or grease off the leather with a clean dry cloth. Do not scrub or rub the area – blot only. The spot should dissipate into the leather after a short period of time. Do not apply water or try to wash a butter, oil or grease spot.

DO NOT USE:

Saddle soap, cleaning solvents, furniture polish, oils, varnish, abrasive cleaners, detergent soaps or ammonia water.

Note:

For stubborn stains, clean the surface using a cloth slightly dampened with distilled water. These are recommended or suggested methods of cleaning. Always try any cleaning method in a hidden area first to test the results. The manufacturer is not responsible for damage incurred while cleaning.

Like any upholstery material, all leathers can fade to some degree if exposed to the sun or direct light.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

American Leather® provides a limited lifetime warranty on the frame and suspension of this piece of furniture. American Leather® also warrants this piece of furniture to be free of defects in workmanship and materials, other than frame and suspension, for five years from the day of purchase. Any battery included with the product is protected by warranty for one year from the day of purchase.

Defects in workmanship and materials are defined, for the purpose of this warranty, as causing the product to be unsound structurally or mechanically, or altering the appearance other than that of normal usage and does not apply to defects resulting from misuse, accidents or negligence.

If a defect is found in this product, American Leather® will repair or replace it, at its discretion. American Leather® reserves the right to arrange local repair. The cost of packaging and shipping to and from the factory is not covered by this warranty unless expressly arranged by American Leather®. Claims under this warranty should be made to the retailer where the product was purchased or through a retailer authorized by American Leather®. The dated receipt should be retained for proof of purchase.

This warranty is offered to the original owner and is not transferable. This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have additional rights which vary from state to state.
