

Glass Requiring AHJ Approval

There are times when certain glass types on the market may be used in specific applications only with Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) approval. This includes but is not limited to glass not meeting the hose-stream requirements after passing the fire-resistance portion of testing, glass that may not meet temperature rise requirements, or non-safety rated glass in impact locations. In certain applications the AHJ may approve the use of such glass types for a specific location and set of circumstances.

Forte[™] Opening Solutions will install glass requiring case by case approval by authority having jurisdiction only if expressly instructed to do so by the Buyer. Such instruction is, and will be, understood by all parties as an affirmative declaration by the Buyer that it has obtained formal approval for the use of glass requiring case by case approval by authority having jurisdiction in a particular application from the authority having jurisdiction.
