Planting Instructions

Select a room with filtered, indirect light. Submerge the root zone in a container of water for 10 minutes, then gently disturb the roots and prune any damaged ones before planting.

Use a 2-gallon pot with drainage holes and a tray underneath. Fill to about halfway with potting soil. Put the plant in the pot and fill with additional soil, gently firming the soil around the pot, then water thoroughly until it drains to the tray below.

Soil Preparation

Combine a ratio of 4:1 native soil to organic compost to cover the root ball when planting the tree.

Continuing Care

Watering

Water once a week or when the soil appears dry. Add enough water that it drains to the tray below. Do not allow the plant to sit in a saucer of water.

Fertilizing

Use a water-soluble fertilizer once every other month for ideal plant growth.

Pruning

Prune your Sago palm at least once a year, cutting browned or yellowed leaves as close to the trunk as possible.
