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To Whom This May Concern:

We have been informed by our supplier, SupHerb Farms of Turlock, CA (“SupHerb”), that out of abundance of caution it is voluntarily recalling one lot of its large cut cilantro (the “Lot”) as the Lot has the potential to be contaminated with small wood particles from a crop previously grown in the field utilized by SupHerb to grow the Lot. The Lot was utilized in the production of SJS’s salsa products between 12/19/2024 to 3/17/2025. SupHerb is a long-time supplier to San Juan Salsa Co. (“SJS”) and complies with our Supplier Management Program including providing yearly 3<sup>rd</sup> party Food Safety Audits and Product Specifications. SJS has had no issues with the product it has purchased from SupHerb to date.

SupHerb has recommended SJS notify its customers of SupHerb’s voluntary recall of the Lot. After thorough review of our manufacturing records, the varieties and “Best Before” dates for SJS’s products that potentially utilized the Lot are outlined below:

1. Mild Salsa	March 3 <sup>rd</sup> to May 23 <sup>rd</sup> , 2025
2. Medium Salsa	February 27 <sup>th</sup> to May 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2025
3. Hot Salsa	March 3 <sup>rd</sup> to May 23 <sup>rd</sup> , 2025
4. Traditional Salsa	January 29 <sup>th</sup> to April 23 <sup>rd</sup> , 2025
5. Pineapple Mango Salsa	March 24 <sup>th</sup> to May 23 <sup>rd</sup> , 2025
6. Verde Salsa	January 21 <sup>st</sup> to April 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2025
7. Mens Room Roasted Red Salsa	March 18 <sup>th</sup> to May 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2025
8. Costco 32 oz. Medium Salsa	February 27 <sup>th</sup> to May 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2025

SJS has not used the Lot in production since March 17, 2025, so no current product is involved in this voluntary recall from SupHerb. For the avoidance of doubt, SJS has not received any notices or complaints from its customers concerning the Lot or any of SJS’s products that utilized the Lot. SJS also believes its internal manufacturing process eliminates the potential for wood particles to be contained as the result of cilantro being utilized in its products.
