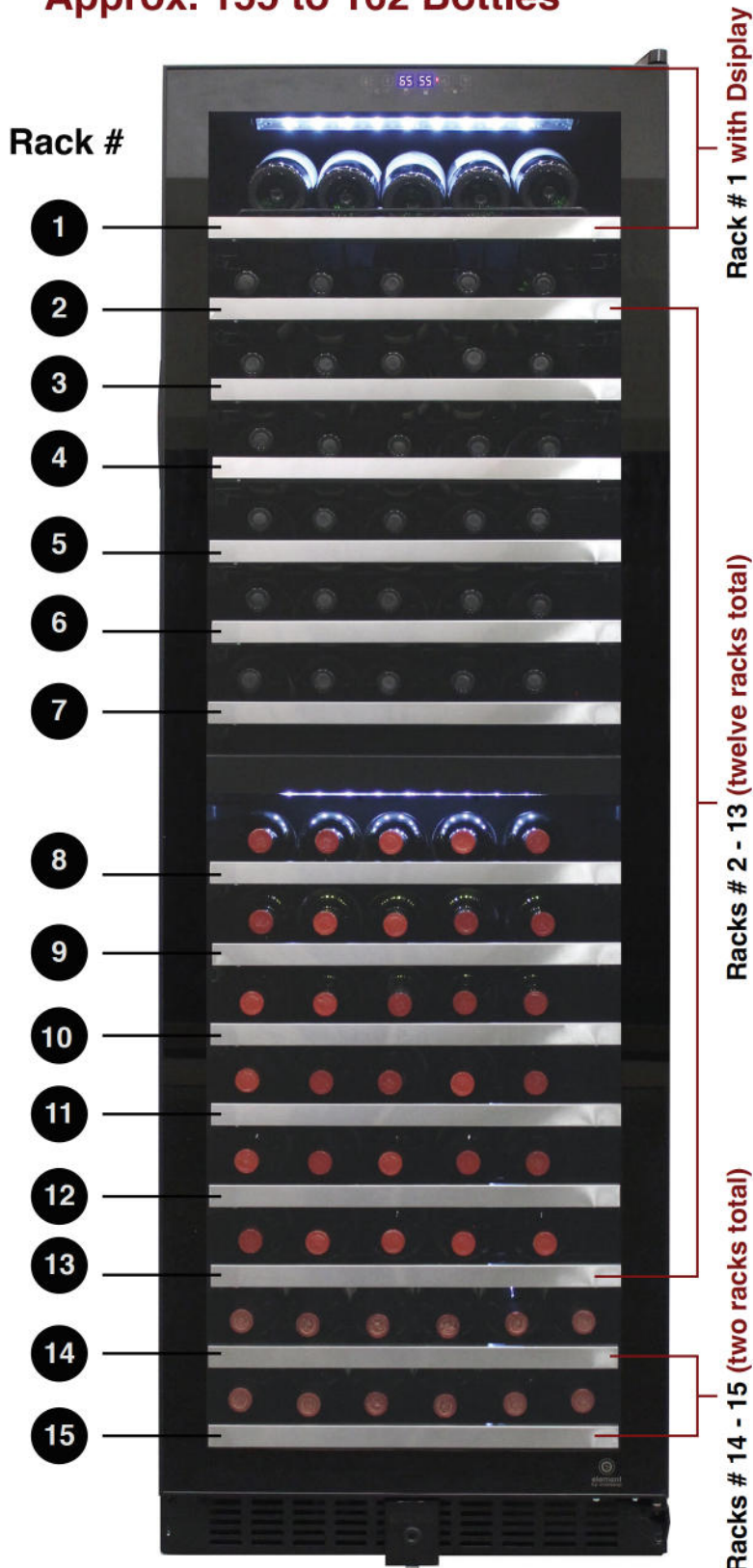


EL-142TSST & EL-142SDST Bottle Capacity

Approx. 155 to 162 Bottles



Note: Bottle capacity is approximate. This cooler is designed to store approximately 155 to 162 standard Bordeaux 750ml bottles. Storing large and/or oddly shaped bottles will decrease the capacity of your cooler.

Rack #1 with Display Rack

Rack #1 with Display Rack Removed

Remove the display rack to configure 11 bottles in the back.

1st Rack Capacity: 16 to 20 Bottles

Using the display will reduce the capacity of the 1st rack from 20 to 16 bottles. (**16 Bottle Option**; 5 bottles fit on the display rack, 11 bottles behind the display. **20 Bottle Option**: If you choose to not use the display you can fit 20 bottles on the 1st rack.

Racks: # 2 - 13



These 2-Bottle deep racks can hold up to 11 bottles per rack

Racks # 2 - 13 Capacity: 132 Bottles Total

This group of 12 racks can hold up to 132 bottles, with 11 bottles per rack.

Racks: # 14 - 15

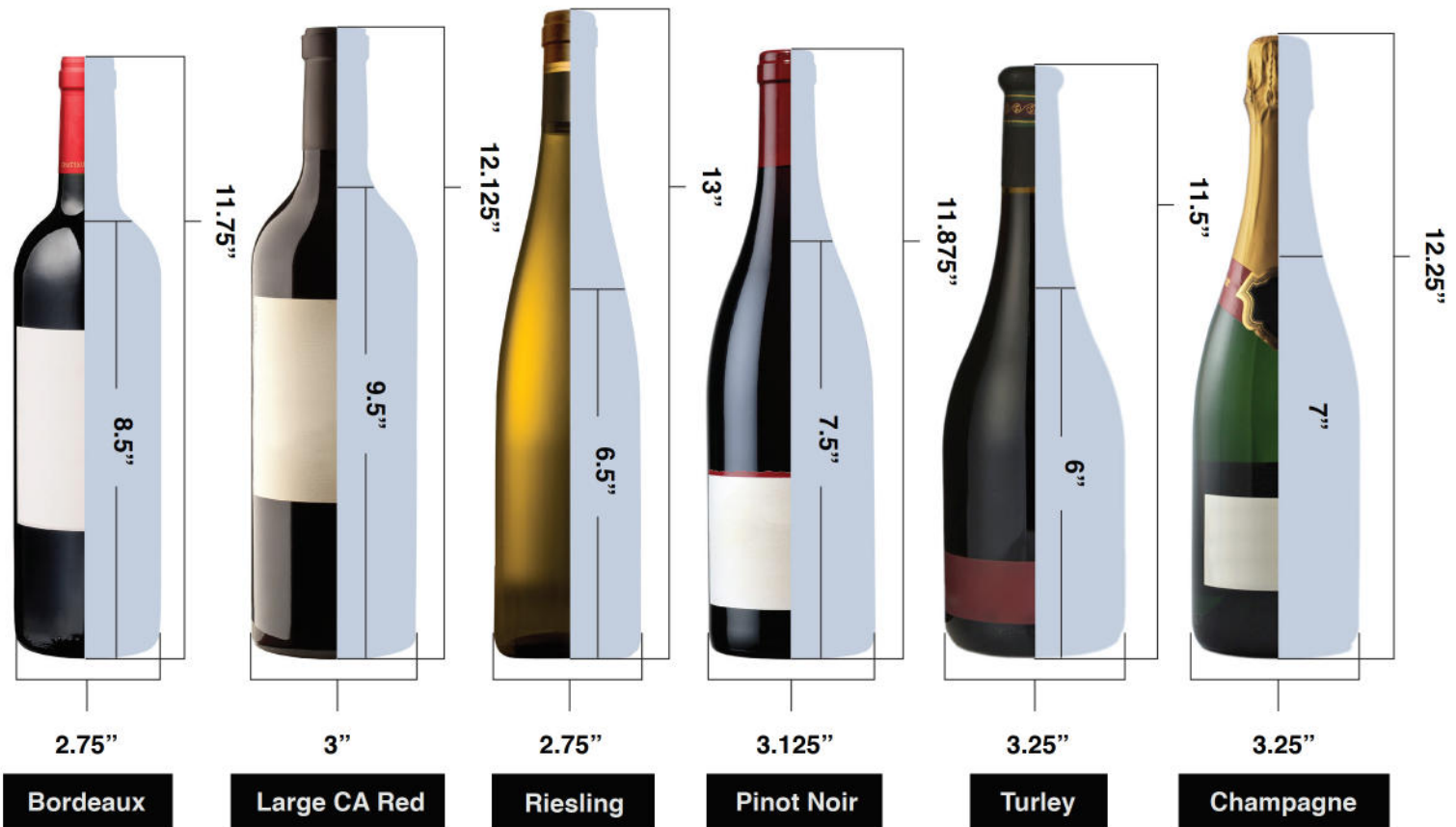


These 1-Bottle deep racks can hold up to 6 bottles per rack

Racks #14 - 15 Capacity: 12 Bottles Total

This set of 2 racks can hold up to 12 bottles, with 6 bottles per rack.

Wine Cooler Bottle Capacity



This chart is provided as a general guide to bottle sizes.

Everyone's collection is different and there are many different bottle sizes and shapes on the market. The bottle capacity listed for Vinotemp wine coolers is for standard Bordeaux 750 ml bottles which are approximately 2.75" in diameter.

Storing large and/or oddly shaped bottles (including champagne and sparkling wine bottles) will decrease the number of bottles you are able to store in your wine cooler.

Interlocking the same type of bottle will decrease wobbling; it is also easier to stack with similar sized bottles.

Wine bottles come in a myriad of sizes and shapes which can affect your wine cellar and storage needs.

Larger format wine bottles are increasing in popularity as wineries produce these sporadically to mark special occasions such as anniversaries or unique vintages. There are several benefits to the large format bottles; they age better which results in a higher quality wine and can be stored for a longer period due to the low oxygen to wine ratio inside the bottle. Conversely, smaller formats like half or quarter bottles age more quickly and should therefore be consumed almost immediately.
