
# Grounding Instructions

\*\* This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for the electric current so as to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.






# Moving and Installation



# Controller Operation Instructions

\*\* An object sensor is applied on rotating footrest. An alarm will sound when an object is detected during the use. After removing the object, press any button shortly to restart the massage.



#### Power

### Power ON/OFF.

Switching off the power while in operation will lead to the full stop of functions and make the massage recliner return to its original resting position.



### Auto Mode

Auto massage button with 4 massaging modes.

- Neck/Shoulder: Relieves fatigue by intensively stimulating the neck and shoulder area.
- [ • ] Waist/Back: Relieves fatigue by intensively stimulating the back and waist area.
- [ • ] Full Body Relaxation: Stimulates from the neck to the waist with massage balls to relieve fatigue.
- [ • •] Full Body Vitality: Provides kneading and tapping to the whole body to relieve fatigue.



### Manual Mode

You can choose the type of massage you want to receive. [5 modes in total: Kneading > Tapping > Combination > Hand Tapping > Acupressure]



### Massage Intensity

This button allows you to adjust the massage intensity in 3 levels.

\*\* Manual massage - During tapping / hand tapping / acupressure, press the button to change the massage head spacing in 3 levels.

\*\* An object sensor is applied on rotating footrest. An alarm will sound when an object is detected during the use. After removing the object, press any button shortly to restart the massage.



### Airbag Massage

Enables the calves air massage unit.

 $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Rotate the leg massager in the opposite direction to automatically turn off the airbag.



### Upper/ Lower Massage Ball

Allows to adjust the up/down position of the massage balls during Manual Mode.

Pressing once will make the massage balls move, pressing twice will make them stop moving.



### Inclining/ Reclining

Allows manual adjustment of the angle of the body. Pressing once will start the movement, pressing twice will stop movement.



### Zero Gravity

Reclining button with 2 angle levels.
