Wood Furniture Care and Cleaning:

- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
 - Use of furniture polishes is not necessary.
Should you choose to use polishes, test in an inconspicuous area first.
 - Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage your furniture's finish.
 - Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
 - Liquid spills should be removed immediately.
Using a soft, clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.
 - Direct sunlight may damage wood finishes.
 - For indoor use only.
 - Extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause warping, shrinking and splitting of wood furniture. It is best to keep furniture in a climate controlled environment.
 - Stains or marks from crayons or ink markers will be difficult to remove.
 - In the event that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.

Fabric Cleaning Code "WS" (Solvent and or water base cleaners)

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered or dry-cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of affected area to prevent circling. Use a professional furniture cleaning service when an overall soiled condition has been reached.
