Planting Instructions

Gently disturb the roots and prune any damaged ones before planting.

Choose a sunny spot (avoiding afternoon sun in areas of extreme heat). Berries need at least 6 hours of full sun to produce fruit. Blueberries do best in acidic soil with a pH balance of 4.5-5.5. We recommend incorporating a soil acidifier, using acidic potting soil, or adding peat moss to your garden soil.

For containers: Choose a container that is 12-16" diameter and at least 10" tall. Fill to about 2/3 full with potting soil, place in the plant, then fill in with soil. Water thoroughly.

For gardens: Dig a hole slightly larger than the container, loosening the soil at the bottom of the hole so it's aerated. Place in the plant, then add soil around it, crumbling the soil to help with aeration. Water thoroughly.

Continuing Care

Watering

Water frequently, ensuring the soil stays moist but not overwatered.

Fertilizing

Use a water-soluble fertilizer once every 2-3 weeks. Discontinue after September 1st and resume when new growth appears in the spring.

Harvesting

Wait to pick berries until they have turned blue, feel firm (but not hard), and come off the plant with little effort.
