To remove cork:

Remove foil before opening wine. Set the Electric Corkscrew on top of bottle, and apply gentle downward pressure. Holding bottle securely, continuously press the downward button. The Corkscrew will automatically stop once the cork is fully removed from the bottle. Lift the corkscrew off the bottle and press and hold the upward arrow to automatically eject the cork.
