- B. *Matteucia struthiopteris*  
(Ostrich Feather Fern)
- C. *Dryopteris erythrosora*  
(Autumn Fern)
- D. *Athyrium filix-femina*  
(Lady Fern)

## Planting Instructions

**While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.**

1. Choose a location that receives full to part shade.
2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
4. Water the soil mixture.

**You're now ready to plant.**

5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
6. Place the roots and/ or bulbs at the depth noted on the label of the package
7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

**After Care**

8. Continue to water and disbud any faded blooms throughout the summer season.
9. In the fall or early spring remove the faded leaves and debris from last years growth.

**Store in a Cool, Dry Place
