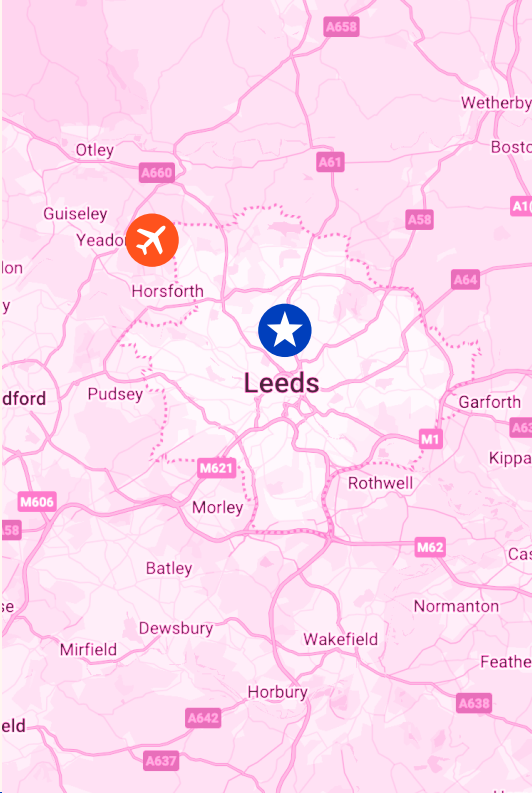
Activities
