Volunteering experience

Students at Bayswater Cape Town can now combine their programme with a meaningful full-day volunteering experience.

By choosing the Volunteering option, students can make a difference while exploring South Africa as they spend time in the local community.

Social volunteering fosters a meaningful exchange, enriching both the lives of those who give and those who receive.

What to expect

When adding the volunteering programme, one afternoon activity per week is replaced with volunteering. Volunteering always takes place on a week day

Students will spend their time actively participating in volunteering tasks, managed by experienced volunteering coordinators

The volunteering activity takes place outside of the city centre, so students have the opportunity to see places that they wouldn't otherwise visit

They will be immersed in an English-speaking environment and interact with locals from the community

Their day will be filled with opportunities to listen to and speak in English as they learn more about the local community and the outreach project

About the project

2Cchange is a registered non-profit organisation, established in 2007

Specialising in supporting young children at daycare facilities, they provide a safe environment for learning, and growth with educational enrichment and feeding schemes

They are involved in Morkel's Cottage informal living settlement in Strand, and the Projekt Ubuntu in the Masipumelele Township between Kommetjie and Noordhoek
