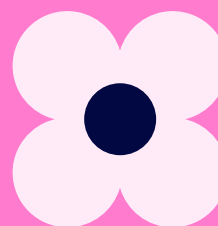

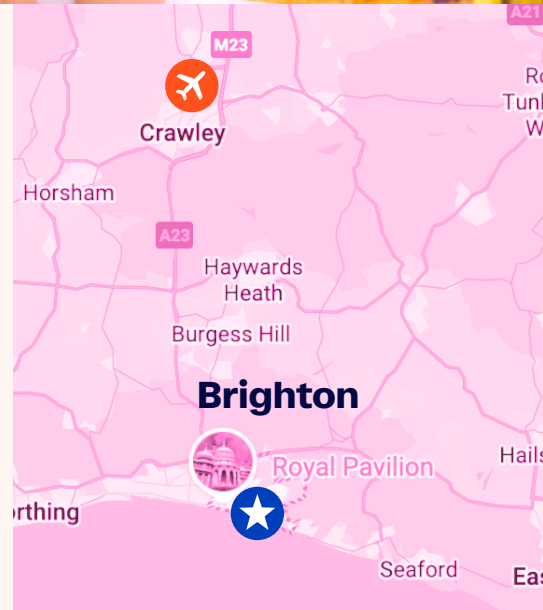
Included in the course
