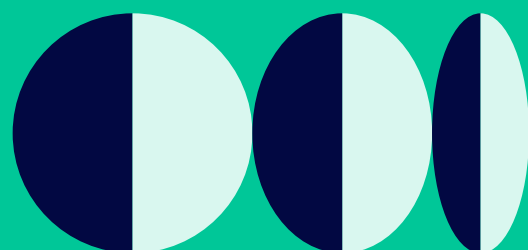

CONEDUQ

We have expanded the number of students we are supporting at CONEDUQ. Following a successful first year where we taught 100 students, we have since increased and are now **teaching over 200**.

Students are assigned speaking and reporting activities on a variety of topics, allowing them to practice and improve their English pronunciation, fluency, and confidence in oral communication. All groups are supported by both a lead teacher and an assistant instructor. This structure allows for more effective classroom management, improved student support, better data collection, and closer monitoring of student progress.



We are now teaching over 200 students!

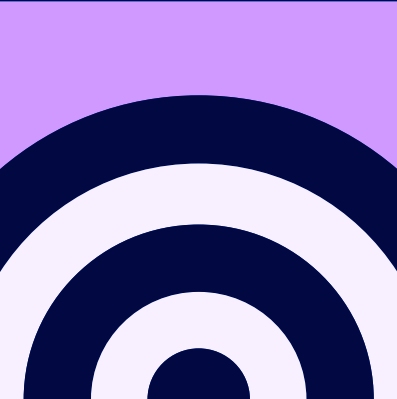
