University and college Pathway Program

5 Steps



Select your university or college program with Bayswater

- Complete the Bayswater online test to see how long you must study English
- Register at Bayswater
- > Choose and apply to Bayswater partner institution



Apply for study permit and arrive in Canada

- > Bayswater provides LOAs and CLOAs from our partner institution
- Apply for your study permit Bayswater provides Provincial Attestation Letters (PALs) required for a study permit application
- > Travel to Canada and start your studies at Bayswater



Study at Bayswater - University and College Pathway Program

- Complete your English studies up to the required Bayswater level and transition directly to your university or college
- You are not permitted to work in Canada while you are an English language student



Start your university or college program

While studying at university or college, you are eligible to work up to 20 hours per week during school terms, and 40 hours per week during scheduled breaks. For more details, please visit the <u>Canada immigration website</u>



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Graduate and apply for post-graduation work permit

Depending on your program, you may be eligible to apply for a Post-Graduation Work Permit for eight months up to three years



What your studies could look like on a B2 and C1 Pathway:

If starting at level 3, a student would need an average of 30 weeks to complete the B2 pathway program, or an average of 42 weeks to complete the C1 pathway program.

Post-Secondary Certificate:

Practical and career-focused.

Duration: 1 year or less **Pre-requisites:** High school Diploma + Bayswater Levels 7 or 9

Post-Secondary Diploma:

Practical and career-focused. Duration: 2 years

Pre-requisites: High School Diploma + Bayswater Levels 7 or 9

Student has graduated from university

Post-Graduate Diploma/Certificate:

Career-focused qualification for practical skill enhancement. Shorter than a master's degree.

Duration: 1 – 2 years **Pre-requisites:** bachelor's degree + Bayswater Level 9

Bayswater University and College Pathway Program

Associate Degree:

Technical and academic foundation. Intended for transferring to a four-year degree.

Duration: 2 years Pre-requisites: High School Diploma + Bayswater Levels 7 or 9 Bachelor's Degree:

Provides theoretical and practical knowledge for specialized fields.

Duration: 4 years Pre-requisites: High School Diploma + Bayswater Levels 7 or 9

Master's Degree:

Specialized program with research and training. Thesis-based and prerequisite for PhD.

Duration: 12 - 18 months **Pre-requisites:** bachelor's degree + Bayswater Level 9

Post-Secondary Certificate: Accounting, Business, Education, Health Care, Hospitality.

Post-Secondary Diploma: Culinary Arts, Design, Engineering Studies, IT & Software, Hospitality, Legal Studies.
