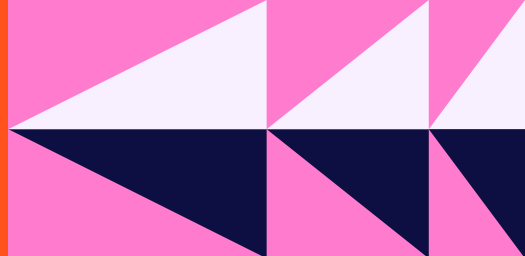
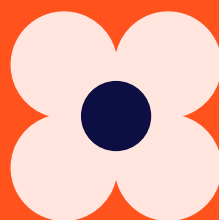
A direct train runs from Toronto Airport to the city centre, where you can take the subway directly to Bayswater Toronto.
