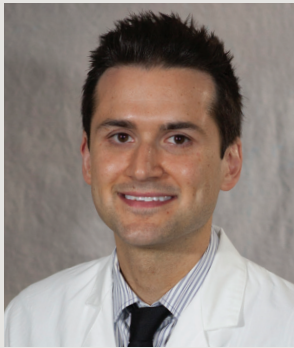

MINIMALLY INVASIVE PROCEDURES AND SERVICES INCLUDE

- Tumor embolization and Y-90 radioembolization
- Microwave and cryoablation
- Prostate artery embolization (PAE)
- Gonadal vein embolization
- Uterine artery embolization (UAE)
- Ovarian vein embolization
- Genicular artery embolization (GAE)
- Hemorrhoidal artery embolization (HAE)
- Transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunt (TIPS)
- Balloon-occluded retrograde transvenous obliteration (BRTO)
- Vertebroplasty and kyphoplasty
- Basivertebral nerve ablation
- Genicular nerve ablation
- Central venous access (port placement)
- Gastrostomy and gastrojejunostomy (feeding tube) placement
- Image guided biopsies
- Biliary, pleural, peritoneal, and urinary drainage

ABOUT INTERVENTIONAL RADIOLOGY

Interventional radiologists are physicians with advanced training in minimally invasive, image-guided procedures. Using X-ray, CT, ultrasound, and MRI guidance, they perform diagnostic and therapeutic interventions through small incisions, providing precise treatment with less pain, lower risk of complications, shorter hospital stays, and faster recovery than many traditional surgical approaches.
