## ANTICOAGULATION CLINIC

The Anticoagulation Clinic is designed for patients taking warfarin (e.g. Coumadin®). If you have a patient that is taking warfarin, you are able to refer them to our pharmacist-managed clinic. Using patient-preferred “finger-stick” sampling, the Point-of-Care INR results are immediately available to the pharmacist and patient, and if needed, dosage modifications are made during the appointment. Upon leaving the clinic the patient knows his/her results, dosage instructions, and when to return to the clinic for follow-up.



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## STRUCTURAL HEART DISEASE AND VALVE CLINIC

The Structural Heart Disease and Valve Clinic's goal is to deliver the highest quality care dedicated to evaluation and management of patients with valvular heart disease.

Minimally-invasive procedures available at the Structural Heart Disease and Valve Clinic include transcatheter aortic valve replacement (known as TAVR), and left atrial appendage (LAA) closure implant. TAVR can help relieve and improve symptoms from severe aortic stenosis and increase life expectancy. The LAA closure implant is a permanent heart implant used to treat atrial fibrillation not caused by a heart valve problem.
