Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PM&R), also known as physiatry, is a physician-led specialty focused on the evaluation and non-surgical management of conditions affecting function and quality of life following illness, injury, or disability. Our team provides comprehensive care for physical and cognitive impairments involving the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves, bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, and tendons.

McLaren PM&R physicians take a whole-person approach to care, addressing functional limitations related to trauma, chronic pain, neurologic disease, and musculoskeletal disorders. Treatment plans are individualized and focused on restoring independence, improving mobility, and optimizing daily function.

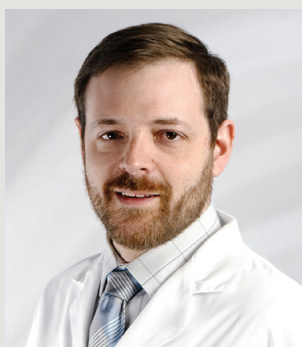
