- Image-guided biopsies
- Tumor embolization, chemoembolization, and radioembolization
- Microwave and cryoablation
- Radiofrequency ablation
- Angioplasty and vascular stenting
- Carotid angioplasty and stenting
- Prostate artery embolization (PAE)
- Uterine artery embolization (UAE)
- Endovenous ablation for varicose veins
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm repair
- Inferior vena cava (IVC) filter placement
- Vertebroplasty and kyphoplasty
- Central venous access (ports and PICC lines)
