





Strategic steps to help you effectively analyze and act on data:



Identify pain points

Use data to pinpoint areas where user experience or workflow may be hindered. Recognizing these pain points allows for targeted improvements that enhance productivity and overall workspace satisfaction.



Select relevant metrics

Identify the key performance indicators (KPIs) that directly align with your objectives and goals established in the <u>Plan</u> stage. When presenting your findings, avoid overwhelming your audience with too much data; instead, provide a concise set of impactful metrics.



Utilize data visualization

Graphs, charts, and dashboards can make complex data more understandable. Visualization tools in Control Hub can help you identify trends and outliers at a glance.



Compare periods

Compare current data with historical data to identify any significant changes or trends over time.
