With AirPlay, anyone can enjoy a smooth sharing experience using Apple and Cisco devices. Don't want to deal with cables? AirPlay is completely wireless, so you can skip connecting cords and jump straight to sharing exciting content.

Apple users, meet AirPlay

AirPlay makes wireless sharing possible for Apple devices. Users can benefit from a simple and familiar sharing experience to wirelessly connect their iPhone, iPad, or Mac to share their screen, collaborate, and playback audio and video content.

Get started with settings

Your administrator must first enable AirPlay, but you can do the following at any time:

- Turn AirPlay on or off
- Open AirPlay settings on Board, Desk, and Room series devices
- Manage your PINs and passwords

Tip: AirPlay works best when your Apple device is running the latest version of iOS/iPadOS/macOS.

Share from an Apple device

To start AirPlay sharing from an Apple device:

1. Open the Control Center on your iPhone, iPad, or Mac. Select Screen Mirroring.
2. Select the Cisco device you want to share to.
3. The Cisco device will show a passcode (depending on how security settings have been configured for that device).
 - Your Apple device will request this passcode.
4. Enter the passcode on your Apple device to establish the share.
 - On Board and Desk Series, swiping up from the bottom of the home screen opens the Task Switcher, and you can move to another app. This will end your share.
