<div><p>Webex Meetings and Cisco devices work together to make it possible to join Webex Meetings directly from Board, Desk or Room Series devices.</p></div>	<div><div>To join from your Cisco device:</div><div><div>Watch the video</div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Tap the Join Webex button on your device or controller's home screen.▪ Enter the meeting number that is listed in the Webex Meetings invite, and tap Join to join the meeting.▪ If joining a Personal Room meeting, you can use the person's name or email address to search for their Personal Room.</div></div></div>

Join with OBTP or by dialing in to the meeting.▪ WebRTC - If VIMT is unavailable, you can still join a MS Teams meeting from your Cisco device using WebRTC, which provides a guest experience. WebRTC has some limitations, and the Microsoft tenant requires anonymous guest access to use WebRTC to join from devices.<p>Admins: Enable WebRTC in Control Hub</p></div></div></div>

How to join and more



Join Google Meet meetings with One Button to Push (OBTP). Invitees can join from their Cisco Board, Room, or Desk series devices.

To join from your Cisco device:

- Tap the **Join** button that appears right before the meeting.
- When you’ve joined the meeting, the device displays the video stream from Google Meet on the main screen with the grid layout by default and the call controls.

With the Zoom button, anyone can join Zoom meetings from their Cisco devices.

To join from your Cisco device:

- Enter the code provided in your calendar invite or at the end of the meeting link.
- Select the **Zoom** button on your device.

Standard-based systems

If you prefer other meeting platforms, you can use Cisco devices to join through SIP standards-based dialing.

To join, dial the URL, and you’re in! If the URI is in the hybrid calendar accepted format, Cisco will automatically scrape and give you OBTP.

Meetings with video addresses automatically appear in your meetings list if:

- You have the Webex App.
- The hybrid calendar is enabled.
- You’re using MS Outlook Exchange, MS Outlook 365, or G Suite for Google Calendar.
- The video address is in the body of the meeting and is in a supported format.
