

Split off from a meeting or webinar into breakout sessions

When you need to take a moment or two and branch off from a Webex meeting or webinar, start a breakout session. It's easy, and any host or cohost can create them. You can select participants and speak with them privately outside of the main session, and attendees can join and leave breakout sessions depending on how the host or cohost has set them up.

Share content and collaboration tools

As a host or cohost, you can join any breakout session to participate in the discussions or provide help. Attendees can share content and use tools like chat to work in smaller, more focused groups.

Create assignments

Select the number of breakout sessions you want to create and how you want to assign your participants. You can assign automatically, manually, or let participants join any session.

Use multiple devices

Enjoy working closely with teams and maximizing collaboration efforts by using breakout sessions on desktop, iPhone, iPad, and Android devices.

Automatic audio and video

Each breakout session is a separate audio and video conference. If you connected to audio when you joined the meeting or webinar, it switches over automatically when you join a breakout session. In meetings, you can mute or unmute your audio and start or stop your video at any time during the breakout session, just like you would in the main meeting.
