

### Contribuez à réduire la discrimination et la violence que subit la communauté LGBTQ+

Cette année, les défilés et les festivals de la fierté seront de retour dans de nombreuses villes du monde après les annulations causées par la pandémie de COVID-19. Les événements de cette année s'inscrivent toutefois dans un contexte de discrimination et de préjugés qui perdurent envers la communauté LGBTQ+. Environ 1 crime haineux sur 5 vise un membre de la communauté LGBTQ+. Il y a une augmentation rapide des cas de violence envers les personnes de la communauté LGBTQ+, et cette tendance est également observée au Canada.

La communauté LGBTQ+ fait constamment face à des menaces de violence et à du harcèlement, et de nouveaux défis s'ajoutent chaque année. Plutôt que d'offrir une protection, de trop nombreux gouvernements adoptent des lois discriminatoires envers une communauté faisant déjà face à des préjugés. 
